Bring your patrols and their sleds to this year's derby, and all should Be Prepared to HAVE FUN with these great activities:

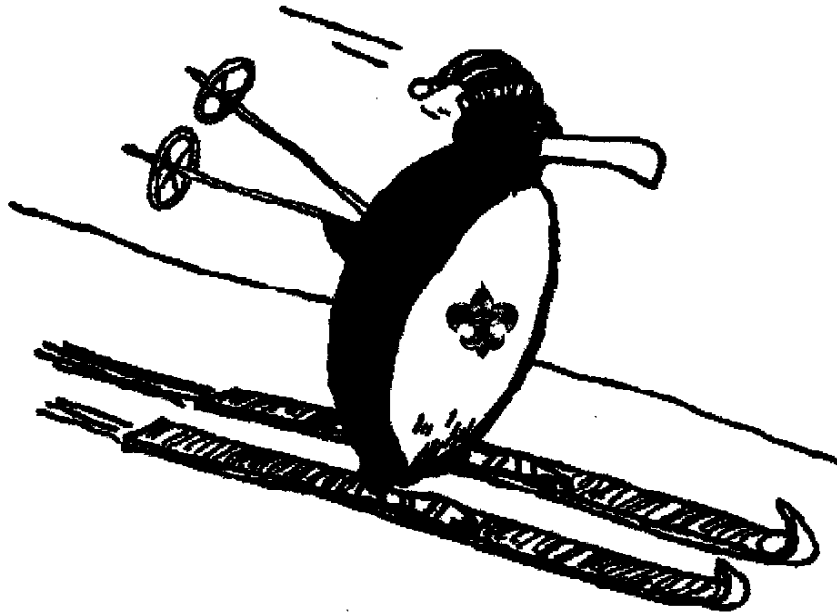

## REQUIRED Sled Equipment List for Klondike

Revised for 2005

The Following items should be on the patrols sleds for use at the various stations.

- 1 - Fire starting material and matches
- 1 - quart of water per scout (minimum)
- Compass (one per scout is desirable)
- 2 - plastic tarps or ponchos
- 1 - patrol sized winter first aid kit
- 1 or 2 - snow shovels
- 1 - saw and or hatchet
- 1 - Sleeping Pad
- 2 Blanket(s)
- 1 - notebook and pencil
- 1 - scout handbook per patrol
- 1 pr - Snow shoes and / or cross country skis per scout
- Food for snacks on the trail for patrol
- Extra socks for each scout
- Extra clothing for each scout, weather dependent
- 1 Hat for each scout
- 2 brooms
- 1 - Gold nuggets storage bag (plastic will not work)
- Scout spirit, including 1 ton humor
- Patrol yell
- Patrol flag

New Scouts **MUST** take part in a gear check at the troop meeting on March 1<sup>st</sup>. They should be prepared with warm gear to hike and/or play in the snow. Snow shoes are recommended and can be rented at EMS, Gart Bros or REI. Each patrol will plan their meals and assign someone to bring their food. Scouts will be setting up camp in the dark on Friday night, so a flashlight/headlamp and jackets/gloves should be packed on top of their stuff or in a small bag to bring in the car with them.
