Troop 188 will be attending the BSA sponsored Spring Camporee campout at MacGregor Ranch in Estes Park, Colorado during the weekend of April 29th – May 1st. We will leave the Linton School parking lot **promptly** at 4:00 PM on Friday, April 29th, and return to Fort Collins around Noon on Sunday, May 1st. Please have your scouts to the Linton parking lot at 3:30 pm on Friday.

Scouts should arrive at the Linton parking lot dressed in their full Class-A scout uniforms and with a sack dinner. They should bring be prepared for either lots of sun and a nice weekend or rain/snow and colder temperatures. Each patrol will plan their meals and assign someone to bring their food. Because of limitations with the MacGregor Ranch site, we will have about a ¾ mile hike into our site. We would like to have the boys tote their gear into the camp site. Please use a backpack if you have one or a duffle-type bag that can be carried that far. The cost for the weekend is \$7 for each scout (food is on top of that and depends on what the patrol decides). Adults are \$2 for the weekend.
