



Michigan Lake Fun Campout April 7 – 9

Michigan Lake is in the Colorado State Forest and is operated by the Colorado Division of Parks. We will be staying in the Old Camp Pennock Lodge and Columbine Lodge, which sleep up to 21 and 15, respectively. (cabins 1&2 on the map).

The cabins are equipped with wooden tables, benches and bunk beds with mattresses. There is no electricity, running water, blankets or bedding. Fire grills and picnic tables are located outside.

Cabins have propane stoves for heat so no wood is needed; there won't be any Jamie points this time! All vehicles entering the park must have a valid parks pass available at the park entrance for \$5. Water is available at the park maintenance shop near the park entrance.

It could be COLD or it could be Warm. There is probably still plenty of snow for snow shoeing, sledding, x-country, and snowball fights. Look out for the Easter Egg hunt, Troop 188 Style!

These are great cabins for games too, so each patrol should bring your favorite board games.
