

Josh G's Eagle Project September 8th & 9th at City Park Permission Slip and Info

Through my Eagle Project you can enhance City Park and earn lots of service hours. We will be redoing a neglected landscape in City Park. First we will have to dig up the weeds and shrub overgrowth, and replace it with weed barrier. We will then dig a large trench and install a rock border. We will then add the finishing touch and mulch the area. On Saturday, the scouts who work all day will be treated to pizza for lunch, but they can bring a sack lunch if they wish. The kids who work all day both days will be treated to an ice cream party at Walruses.

Saturday 8:30am - 4:30pm: I will meet the scouts by the cannon in City Park (call me if you need further detail at (970)-556-4962.) We will then walk to the site and proceed with the project. Be sure to bring a permission slip. All scouts should be ready to dig and have a fun time.

Sunday 8:30am - 11:30pm: The time may/will change depending on how far we get on Saturday. I will meet the scouts at the same place and we will proceed as the day before. When we finish everything, the scouts who worked the entire project will be treated to an ice cream party at Walruses after the other scouts have left. Scouts who didn't come both days can come to Walruses, but will need to bring their own money.

What should you bring? Bring a filled Water Bottle, Sunscreen, a Dad (if possible), Work Gloves, and sack lunch if you want on Sunday (lunch is provided on Saturday for those who work all day.)

Directions (from Timberline Church):

5.4 mi – about 14 mins

1. Head north on S Timberline Rd toward Custer Dr 1.4 mi 3 mins
2. Turn left at E Prospect Rd 0.3 mi 1 min
3. Turn right at Riverside Ave 1.5 mi 4 mins
4. Slight left at E Mulberry St 2.0 mi 6 mins
5. Turn right at Sheldon Dr 0.2 mi 1 min
6. Turn left at City Park Dr 331 ft
7. Meet at City Park at the cannon by the play ground
