Friday:

If you can't be there at 9 but can come later just let me know and we can work it out.

Saturday:

We will finish everything we couldn't on Friday.

So what should you bring? Well:

Water Bottle (with water in it)

Sunscreen

Work Gloves

Shovel

If you have an extra Wheel Barrow, it would be greatly appreciated if you could bring it along.

Same goes for manual post hole diggers.

It may shock you but yes, you will go further west than Taft Hill

Turn left on Yorkshire. (The last streetlight on Drake)

The 6th street on your left will be Dixon Creek Lane. Follow this to the end of the culdesac
