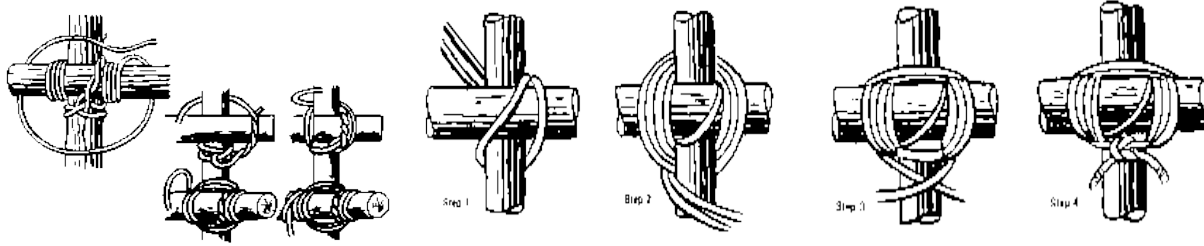


# Boy Scout Troop 188
