The Christmas tree pickup is a great way for our boys to earn money for their scout accounts. This money can be spent on Scout related equipment or events. 75% of the money collected will go to the boys in proportion to the number of hours that they worked.

The boys will meet at the Linton parking lot at 10:00am on December 12, 2009. We will organize them into teams and will go door-to-door distributing pamphlets into the neighborhoods surrounding Linton. The pamphlets will describe the Christmas Tree Pickup event scheduled for January 2. Expect to be completed in 3 hours.

CHRISTMAS TREE PICK UP: JAN 2, 2010 – MEET AT LINTON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AT 1:00 (AFTER MBU – LUNCH WILL BE SERVED) – CLASS A OR B UNIFORM

The boys will meet at the Linton parking lot at 1:00pm. This event immediately follows MBU, and as a result we plan to feed the boys some lunch. We will organize the boys into teams. We will drive through the neighborhoods surrounding Linton and pickup all the Christmas trees that have been left at the curb side. We will collect these trees into trailers and pickups. We will take these trees to the Edora Park for recycling.

Maps will be provided to the adult drivers to make sure that our effort is coordinated. If you have a cell phone, a Family Radio (Walkie Talkie), and/or a trailer or pickup truck please bring them.

The events should be complete in 3-4 hours. The boys will need to bring a water bottle and a cell phone if they have one.
