Wicking Socks and liners

Sunglasses or goggles

Head covering

Sun screen

Water bottle or camel back, and extra for car ride

Energy snacks, gorp, etc. and some for car ride

Light lunch (PB &J, dried fruit, etc.)

Layers for upper body (no cotton)

Compass

Flashlight/headlamp (just in case)

First aid kit

Small or medium backpack.

Optional: Gators, Walkie Talkie
